Buses to return to Days Road and Harrison Road

New 230 and 232 bus routes coming soon

Thank you for providing feedback as part of the overall engagement process for the reinstatement of modified bus routes 230 and 232 on Days Road, Pym Street and Harrison Road.

Consultation also took place with:

- City of Port Adelaide Enfield
- City of Charles Sturt

This feedback, combined with other criteria including local area traffic modelling and a safety risk assessment, was used to determine the best overall outcome for the community and public transport users.

New route 230

Bus route 230 will be modified to operate via Torrens Road, Days Road and Regency Road.

New route 232

Bus route 232 will be modified to operate via Torrens Road, Harrison Road, Pym Street, Oldsmobile Terrace, Stacey Street, Pedder Crescent and Regency Road (Option 1).

This outcome reflects the majority of the feedback received which supported Option 1 and highlighted the importance of bus routes close to the local community, providing shorter walking distances to access services. While some civil works are required, including minor amendments to some intersections and introducing parking restrictions in some locations, the roads were assessed as being adequate for bus operations.

What happens next?

From 15 May, the Adelaide Metro project team will consult with local residents and property owners on specific bus stop locations.

You will be contacted directly if there is intention to place a bus stop or Adelaide Metro infrastructure in front of your property.

The City of Port Adelaide and Enfield will then undertake civil works throughout June–July in preparation for the infrastructure changes.

When will the new service start?

The new 230 and 232 bus services are expected to be operational from Monday 24 July 2023.
